

# SONG MATE™

## Instruction Manual

This is an introduction program for composing simple music with Compumate™. You will be introduced, step by step, the basic idea of music construction and appreciation.

(One song will be stored in each buffer 1 and 2 whenever loading has completed each time.)

Further descriptions on the tape loading and program instructions.

You are assumed that you have read the General Tape Loading Procedures from the back of the cassette hanging card. Before carrying out the described steps, you have to make sure that the Music Mode should be selected on point 5 (i.e. press **[FUNC]** and **[MUSIC]** keys simultaneously).

Before going any further, please revise some of the keys function, eg **[FUNC][GET]**, **[FUNC][SPACE]**, **[FUNC][END]**, **[END]** and **[BUFFERS]** and **[BUFFERS]** keys etc. at the music mode, from the Compumate™ user's manual.

### Notice:

- 2 keys enclosed by a rectangle means both keys are pressed together.
- Before you enter any note, first you have to go back to the 1st note by pressing **[FUNC][SPACE]** otherwise the Compumate will not allow you to enter any note because the time between the 1st note of channel 1 and 1st note of channel 2 will be non-defined.

### Introduction program for young composer.

Go through tape loading step 1-7



Press 'STOP' when you hear the short melody.

## 1 Demo Song

Please try your best to distinguish the differences in melody of the same song 'Long Long Ago' among buffer **[1]**, **[2]** and **[4]**. Press buffer keys **[1]**, **[2]** and **[4]**.

Press **[1]** The song 'Long Long Ago' is played.

Press **[2]** The same song, but the rhythm is changed.

Press **[4]** A new melody from the same song.

## 2 One Key Playing

Please try your best to get the correct rhythm for the song 'Long Long Ago' by pressing key **[6]**.



1. Press **[FUNC][LOAD]**



4. Press or **[AUTOPLAY]**

The song 'Long Long Ago' is played on channel one but the duration of each note is identical.

5. Press **[6]** Try to play the song and get the correct duration of each note by pressing the key **[6]**.

6. Press **[AUTOPLAY]**. Then you can hear the melody that you have entered.

If your rhythm is incorrect, start once again by—

- (i) Holding the keys **[FUNC][SPACE]** until it returns to the 1st note, or
- (ii) Press **[FUNC][NEW]** - **[FUNC][GET]** - **[1]**

## 3 Harmony Playing

Key in the Harmonic notes in channel 1, and then enjoy this dual channels music playing.

1. Press **[FUNC][LOAD]**



1. Press **[1]**



The song has no harmonic notes at channel 2.

2. Press **[FUNC][GET]** Press **[1]**

3. Press **[2]** Turns to channel 2.

4. Key in the notes 5. Press **[AUTOPLAY]**

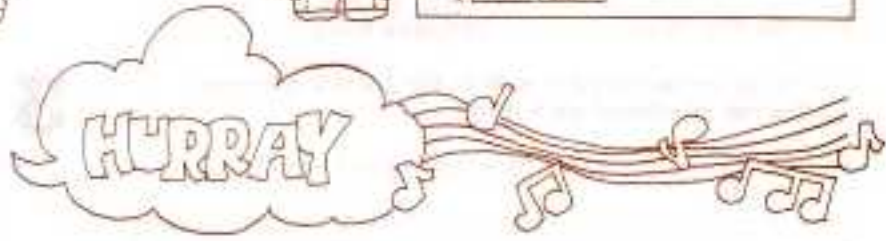
